## INTERNATIONAL BENCHMARK SURVEYS AS INDICATORS

- Relying on just one set of indicators can result in important information gaps.
- International benchmark surveys offer diverse, and robust evidence relevant to the public and researchers.



## LINK RRI INDICATORS TO THE UNESCO RECOMMENDATION ON SCIENCE AND SCIENTIFIC RESEARCHERS

- 195 countries have signed up to a legal obligation to report on 10 major areas of RRI.
- Consistent measurement on a regular long-term timescale = higher quality data.
